Red "Extreme"		Chemical-free sanding and repair of stains and burns
Red & Black "Hybrid"		Removal of orange peel, scratches, bumps and other surface damages

^[3] Final gloss will depend on many variables like floor type, surface texture, wear, cleaning operation process, etc.

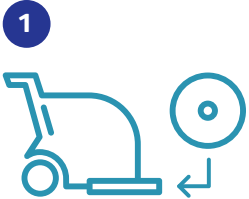

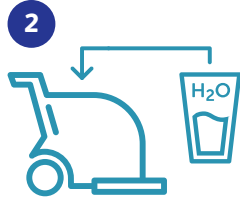
